### September 2007:

*The Journey of Discipleship (JOD)* was printed. I worked with four other women for several years on this project.

1. Presented *Journey* at Trinity Evangelical, Marble Hill, GA and Heatherwood, Newnan, GA. Discipling groups start in Newnan; Trinity wants more training.
2. Spoke at Winthrop Baptist in Taunton MA. Three women I disciplined are discipling nine others using *JOD*.

### October 2007

3. Spoke to 90 women at The Fellowship in Easton, MA. Thirty books were bought that day with many women starting *JOD*.
4. Spoke on "Holy Habits" at Vision New England women's ministries in more than twenty churches.

### November 2007

5. Attended the Navigator national staff conference in St. Louis. Many *JODs* were scooped up by excited women who disciple at colleges, inner city, military and churches.
6. Brookville Baptist, Holbrook, MA begins *JOD* and they love it!
7. Began to meet with the pastor's wife of a large ethnic inner city church. She is very interested in bringing me in to disciple the women in leadership.

### January 2008

8. Beacon Home School Moms, Middleboro MA began *JOD*.
9. *JOD* begins in a group of 16 in Andover, MA (see comments below).
10. Abundant Life, Braintree, MA begins *JOD*.
